White City Play Project aims to register and create a new charitable company limited by guarantee that will look to sustain and further develop White City Play Project and the service it provides. The charity, White City Play Association will be established primarily as a constituted organisation to draw down a wider spread of charitable funding available. The play association will continue running the free open access provision for children of White City and Wormholt across all holiday periods and seek to promote a greater understanding and tolerance for playful behaviours in the local area.

The objects of White City Play Association are:

- 1) *White City Play Association upholds all children's right to play as outlined by the UNCRC Article 31. White City Play Association works through a lens of sufficiency as recognised by the General Comment 17 across the area of benefit to ensure all conditions are permissive for children to access a wide range of play opportunities in the communities they reside in.*
- 2) *White City Play Association provides free open access adventure play provision and believe that access to playful opportunities is critical to both individuals and community holistic health and well-being.*
- 3) *White City Play Association works to address social disadvantage; through working at the forefront of innovative and quality playwork practice, developing unique methods of operation including research and focusing on the training and development of young people and adults in adult education and training.*

White City Play Association are seeking committed individuals from a range of backgrounds and disciplines that primarily have an interest in White City, children's play and charitable organisations to join the board of trustees to allow the service to succeed in meeting its objectives. The charity is also seeking people with skills and experiences in accountancy, treasury, third sector organisations, governance and strategic development. The position of trustee will be voluntary and require a commitment to attend meeting initially on a bi-monthly or six weekly basis.
