(Male Dentist)

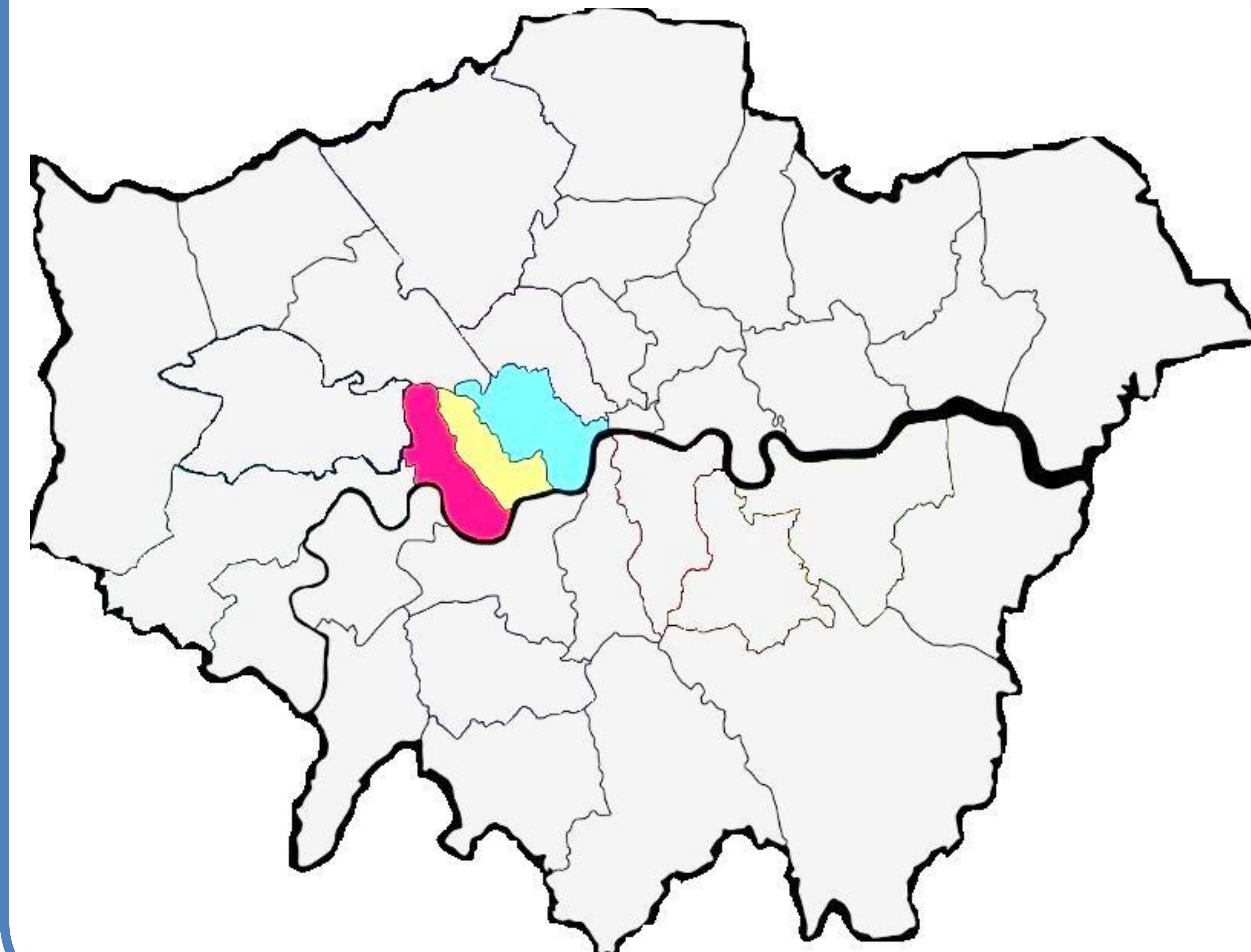
Fridays: 9.30am - 3.30pm
