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AY Group Community Services CIC is a not for profit organisation which is planning to provide a Community Hub where people of all ages, cultures and abilities are encouraged to use the community facilities offered.

THE AIM IS TO PROVIDE COMMUNITY COHESION AND WELLBEING.

Our dynamic and commercially minded CEO who is actively researching all avenues of funding, local support and service users. He believes passionately, that London is in desperate need of Community Hubs to provide a safe, secure and pro-active set of services. The aim is to provide services that will promote social enterprise; training services; employment and entrepreneurial opportunities within in the local area.

Hammersmith & Fulham is an Inner west London borough which has great affluence. It has the lowest unemployment ratio in London at 3.46%, having fallen from 5.7% in 2011-2013 (which was only the 8th lowest rate). Hammersmith & Fulham also one the lowest percentages of low-paid residents at 16%, as well as the greatest decrease in low paid residents in the past three years.

Despite this, poverty is a problem in Hammersmith & Fulham with the 30.5% poverty rate above the London average of 27%. It only gained a few new affordable homes between 2013 and 2016, and even the cheapest rents are more expensive than in most other boroughs. Premature mortality is worse in Hammersmith & Fulham than in any other borough.

FACTS:

- **31%** of people in Hammersmith and Fulham are living in poverty
- **53%** of households in temporary accommodation in Hammersmith and Fulham were placed out of borough
- **3.5%** of working-age people are unemployed in Hammersmith and Fulham
- **235** Knife Crime Offences were reported in Hammersmith & Fulham, between March 2017 and March 2018

THE VISION

It will also promote community cohesion through dialogue and discussions at the centre where all groups from diverse backgrounds will be welcome. We will attract new groups and maintain our existing groups. Our aim will be to provide a service that will exceed the expectation of our customers.
