## London-wide befriending scheme for adult refugees and asylum seekers

We're on a mission to enrich the lived experience of refugees and asylum seekers in Greater London.

HostNation has matched 200 socially-isolated refugees and asylum seekers to a London friend someone who can spare a few hours a week to meet up and show them London.

Our befrienders are all screened and checked. Many work for NGOs or in caring professions and have experience of supporting refugees and other vulnerable groups. We ask for an initial commitment of 3 months but some already tell us they're friends for life!


## Then please take 10 minutes to go online with them and refer them to HostNation.
