

CLOSED ROAD RUNNING EVENT SUNDAY 17TH NOVEMBER 2019



The Fulham 10K, in aid of Great Ormond Street Hospital, is back for a second year and will take place on Sunday 17th November from Eel Brook Common, with its route exploring a range of roads across the borough (please see map overleaf).

ROAD CLOSURES WILL AFFECT YOUR AREA

The route and road closure timings have been carefully considered and selected through a partnership with the local authority, emergency services and Transport for London to minimise the inconvenience of the necessary road closures. Emergency services will be operating as usual so please follow normal procedures in the case of an emergency. Pedestrian footpath access will be unaffected across the event route, but there will be no vehicle or bicycle access on these roads during the road closure period. Bus diversions will also be in place for the event so do visit www.tfl.gov.uk to see if your journey will be affected.

This letter includes a map overleaf which details the exact road closure and reopening times, as well as key local access routes that will be available at set times. We hope this will enable movement on the morning of the event if leaving your property from a road affected by the closures. Event stewards will be in place across the route during all closure times to assist you should you need any help. Where possible, we will reopen roads early to minimise local disruption.

The roads used by the run route are listed overleaf. Where roads are listed multiple times, please refer to the map which highlights where and at what time that road is expected to be closed. A full list of roads affected by the closures can be found on our website (www.adidascityruns.com/fulham). Advance warning signs for road closures will be erected 2 weeks before the event. Parking and loading will not be permitted on single yellow lines on roads on the run route. Some parking suspensions will be in place. Any vehicles parked illegally will be towed.

We are working with social carers, local services such as meals on wheels and community nurses to facilitate access during closure times where possible. If you have plans that you think may be impacted by the planned road closures which cannot be amended, such as travel arrangements, formal events or carer responsibilities we strongly recommend residents to please contact us prior to the event and we will assist wherever possible. The contact details below will also be in operation on Sunday 17th November from 05:30 should unplanned requirements unfold needing assistance.
