What will be expected of panel members? You will need to be able to commit to attending a majority of meetings. These will take place once a month (dates will be circulated in advance) for 1 hour at a time, on a Thursday between 4.30-5.30pm. It will be held virtually using the MS team's Video platform (similar to Zoom) – so access to a computer, camera and microphone will also be needed.

What experience is needed? You do not need any experience to become a member of the panel, just enthusiasm for improving information and support. We are looking to have people with a variety of different experiences on the panel so that we can make sure the information and support we provide is relevant for everyone using our services.
