- **Location:** Currently mostly home-based but may work from our COVID-19 secure offices at the Beethoven Centre in North Westminster. Flexible arrangements likely to apply after the end of the pandemic.
- **Salary:** £24,000 per annum plus 5% pension contribution
- **Hours:** 37.5 hours per week 9am to 5.30pm with 30 minutes for lunch, to include some unsocial hours
- **Holiday:** 25 days plus bank holidays

The successful candidate will be empathetic and committed to supporting carers, with excellent organisational, administrative and ICT skills. This is a busy and demanding role which requires attention to detail and persistence. You must enjoy and be confident in working with technology as caseworkers have to use the local authority's IT system for carer's assessments: full training is provided but you will need to be comfortable working with both a Carers Network laptop and one supplied by the council.

The role is full-time and is not open to part-time or job share roles because we have a limited number of council laptops for use by our team.
