New Parkinson's UK online working age carers support group

Who is the support group for?

Parkinson's UK's **new Online Working Age Carers and Family Support Group set to launch in September 2023 -** has been established to bring together carers and family members of people recently diagnosed with Parkinson's for mutual support.

The group is open to all carers and family members aged over 18 and under 67 supporting someone newly diagnosed with Parkinson's. You do not have to be a registered carer.

The informal online sessions are facilitated by volunteers with caring experience and a chance to talk with people in similar situations, share experiences, and support each other.

We aim for the group to provide mutual support to those living with or caring for a person diagnosed with Parkinson's within (approximately) the last 3 years. If you do not meet the newly diagnosed or age criteria, we host another online carers support group, which you are welcome to join.

For carers under the age of 18, we suggest finding a group specifically aimed for young carers would best meet your needs.

This online group is for peer-to-peer support and is not monitored by professional advisers. If participants want additional or one-to-one support, they may be signposted by volunteers to other groups, services, or other Parkinson's UK support opportunities.

Meeting details

We aim to hold the first monthly meeting in September 2023.

The meeting will last 90 minutes and be held via Zoom or Google Meet. A link to join each meeting will be sent to you in advance. You can also join via phone if you don't have internet access. If you need support using Zoom or Google Meet please let us know.
